

Hamish helps take Scotland to Gold

Tenterden's Hamish Roberts helped the Scottish under 21s take gold in an exceptional performance by Scotland U21 Men as they beat Russia 9-0 in the final to win gold at the EuroHockey Championship II. The Scots had already secured promotion to A-Division but won the competition in style in a dominant final performance.

Scotland took the lead early in the final when Hamish Roberts converted with a good strike to make it 1-0. A slick attack from the left was finished well by Roberts



from close range to put Scotland ahead.

In the semi-final, against long term rivals Ireland, Hamish also helped secured victory with the only goal of the tie as Scotland won 1-0 to secure their place in the final against Russia.

Hamish learnt his hockey with periods playing at Ashford, Folkestone and Canterbury Hockey Clubs. He is currently a student at Loughborough University and has received support from the Kent Playing Field Association who have helped to fund some of his training commitments, which requires regular trip to Edinburgh and Glasgow.

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
