- CLUB ENTRY** The form attached below to be completed and returned no later than **Friday, 16th April 2027**. Arrangements, including handicaps, for the preliminary rounds to be left to the discretion of each club, within the commitment of their competition programmes. In the preliminary rounds or in the final competitors must not start a stipulated round with more than five clubs, one of which must be a putter.
- PLAY** Competitors shall use five clubs only, one of which must be a putter.
There will be a separate Tournament for each Men's Club and each Ladies' Club throughout the County. The Rules of Golf and Local Rules shall apply.
Winners in the preliminary rounds qualify to compete in an 18-hole Stableford Competition Final playing off current active handicap but not more than 28 for Men and 36 for Ladies.
- ENTRY FEES & CLOSING DATE** The preliminary entrance fee will be - **£5.00 per competitor.**
Preliminary rounds should be completed by Friday 21st May 2026.
All results, including finalists' names addresses, telephone numbers/emails and handicaps, together with all preliminary entrance fees payable, should be received by the Association's Secretary not later than the closing date – **Friday 28th May 2027.**
- FINALS DAY** **£20.00 per competitor payable on the day.**

This **Stableford Competition of 18 holes** will be played over the course of **Canterbury Golf Club, Scotland Hills Littlebourne Road, Canterbury CT1 1TW Telephone: 01277 453532** by kind permission of the Captain and Committee, on **Tuesday 15th June 2027**. Players, please refer to club dress code if in any doubt.

The Committee of the KCPFA hopes that every club entering should be represented on Finals Day. When a player who has qualified for the Stableford Competition is unable to compete, a substitute should be deputed by the Club concerned to fill the vacancy.
- PRIZES** In addition to the Men's and Ladies' Challenge Cups; three prizes will be awarded for competition by men and three for ladies on the Finals Day. **Please note, only winners who are prepared to wait for the presentation will receive prizes.**
A prize for the longest drive, and nearest to the pin, on holes to be specified, will be awarded to both men and lady competitors on Finals Day
A memento/gift bag will be awarded to the finalist representing each club.

All proceeds of this Tournament will be donated to the Association's Charity Funds.
